

WHAT IS YOUR VISION FOR LAFAYETTE?

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

The City of Lafayette's 2040 General Plan will be the blueprint for how and where the City will grow over the next 20 years and will guide the future character and quality of development.

The General Plan centers community priorities around conservation and development to define a desirable balance for Lafayette's social, environmental and economic values.



WHAT'S A HOUSING ELEMENT?

It is the chapter (or "element") of the General Plan focused on how the city can achieve an adequate supply of safe, decent housing for residents. It addresses:

- Meeting the City's Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA) to be part of a regional solution
- Maintaining and preserving existing housing stock
- Retaining the character of residential neighborhoods
- Providing additional affordable housing, particularly for senior citizens and young families
- Affirmatively further fair housing by removing patterns of segregation

HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?

The process of updating the General Plan is being guided a group of 11 of your neighbors who have volunteered to serve on the General Plan Advisory Committee (GPAC).
