Join the East Bay Regional Park District for an unveiling of a historic panel installation in recognition of the Lafayette-Moraga Regional Trail's 45th Anniversary to be celebrated at the very site of the original dedication of the trail on July 4, 1976. During the early 1970's, two women known as "the bike ladies" – Avon Wilson and Lynn Hiden began advocating for bicycle safety in the Lamorinda area and promoted the idea of a trail to allow young people to safely ride bikes to and from school. Out of this initial idea, Lafayette City officials and Park District staff began planning one of the first regional trails for the Park District along an abandoned Sacramento-Northern Railroad right-of-way, which blazed the path for "Rails-to-Trails" projects in the United States.

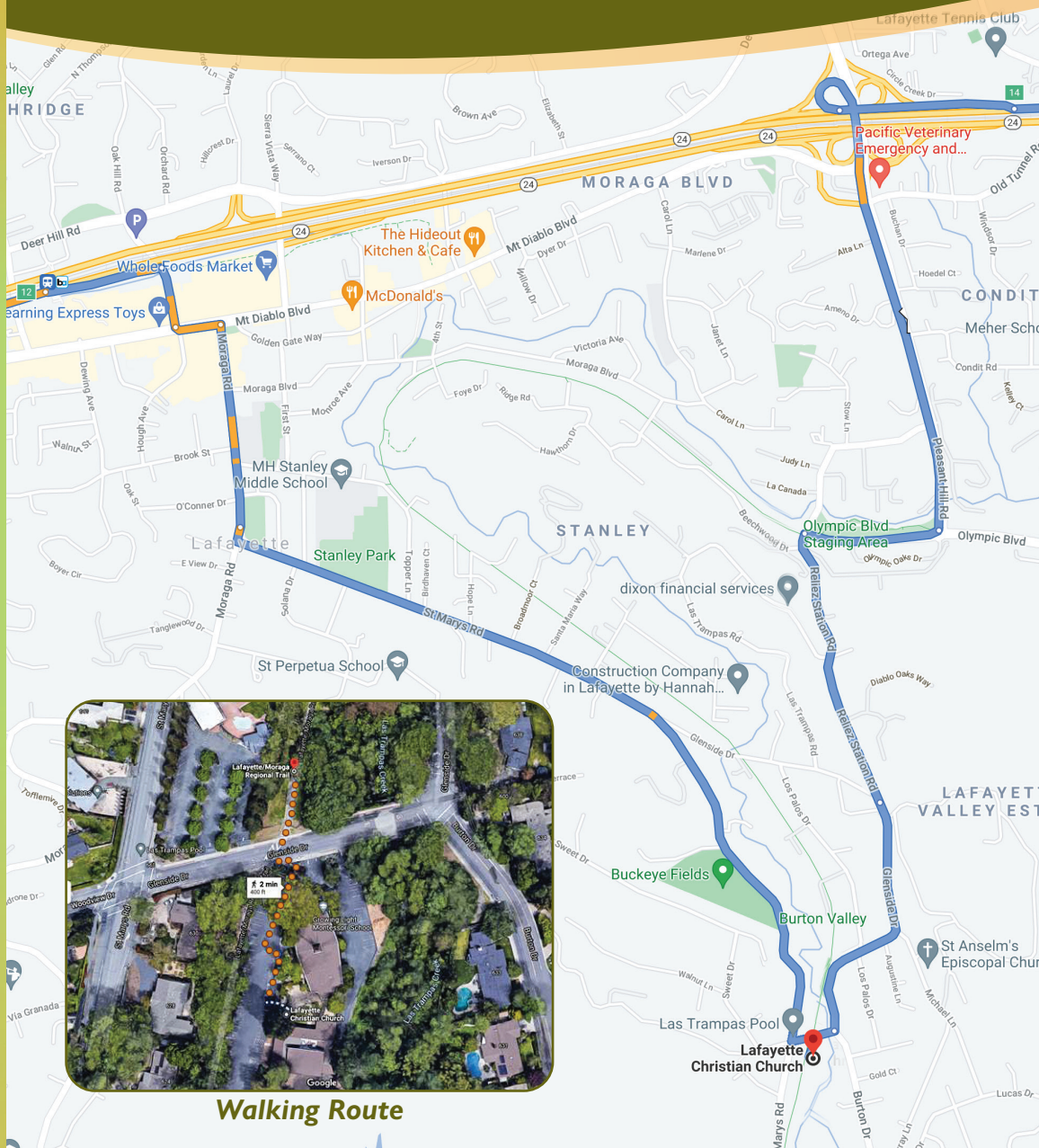

Driving Directions

From Highway 24, east bound from Oakland:

- Take exit 12 for Oak Hill Rd. Toward Central Lafayette.
- From the exit ramp, turn right onto Oak Hill Rd.
- Use the middle lane to turn left onto Mt. Diablo Blvd.
- Turn right onto Moraga Rd.
- Turn left onto St. Marys Rd.

- Turn left onto Glenside Dr.
- Turn right.
- Lafayette Christian Church will be on your left.

From Highway 24, west bound from Walnut Creek:

- Take exit 14 toward Mt. Diablo Blvd.
- Keep right at the fork,

- follow signs for Lafayette/Rossmoor and merge onto Pleasant Hill Rd.
- At the traffic circle, take the first exit onto Olympic Blvd.
- Turn left onto Reliez Station Rd.
- Merge onto Glenside Dr.
- Turn right to stay on Glenside Dr.
- Lafayette Christian Church will be on your left.
