Cost: \$65 April 2 to April 5; \$70 after the 5th. Tickets must be purchased by April 12.

Tickets are nonrefundable.

Time: The prom begins with arrival at 5:30 with dinner served at 6:30. Students must arrive by 6:15 and **MAY NOT LEAVE** until the end of the dance at 10:00. The students are our responsibility during those hours. The Country Club has rules that students not loiter in the parking lot and are to please enter the ballroom upon arrival. We are their guests and need to cooperate so that their members also have access to the Club.

Rules: Any evidence of chemical use or possession of any drugs or alcohol will cause us to notify you and you will be required to come and take the couple home. Further school consequences will be suspension or expulsion according to his/her previous school record. Since graduation is only one month away, we encourage you to speak to your son/daughter and discourage any actions or choices that may put participation in jeopardy. No smoking. Smoking is not permitted in the Country Club. Appropriate behavior (dance) is expected.

Dress: Boys are expected to be in tuxedos. Coupons are available in the Main Office. Boys may remove their jackets only. Ties are to remain on. (Get your money's worth.)

Girls' dresses are to be appropriate for a prom: no plunging necklines or backs that are totally bare or down to.... Slits should be no higher than 3 inches above the knee.

If the dress is inappropriate, you will receive a call to come for your daughter and date.
