» SEMIA Feminist Fund's second call for grants is now open! Last year, SEMIA received more than 250 applications. If you are an Italian organization and have questions about the application process, explore the available information [here](#) or get in touch with SEMIA directly.

In addition, SEMIA recently published the Cittadinanze Sospese report, which examines the shrinking space for democracy in Italy and the rise of anti-gender movements. The report is currently available only in Italian, but an English translation is expected soon—stay tuned!
