OPPORTUNITY YOUTH: 2024 POLICY AGENDA

FOR YOUTH, FOR FAMILIES, FOR COMMUNITIES, FOR BUSINESSES, FOR CONNECTICUT.

Faced with the needs of **Connecticut's 119,000 disconnected or at-risk youth** – young people who have either dropped out of school or are in danger of dropping out of school, and who are, for those aged 18 to 26, unemployed and in many cases without the skills to gain employment – a coalition of Connecticut stakeholders are working together with our elected officials as the Opportunity Youth Initiative.

Public investment in disconnected youth is essential to promote economic growth and social equity and prepare the next generation of workers for a rapidly changing job market.



Each year, 10,000 new young people in Connecticut are falling into being disconnected from work or school.*

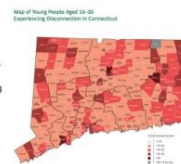
A STATEWIDE ISSUES REQUIRES A STATEWIDE APPROACH

Disconnected youth live in every municipality in Connecticut – rural, urban and suburban – and success in breaking the status quo requires a comprehensive, statewide approach informed by leading national practices and customized for Connecticut's current business climate.

ACTIONABLE SYSTEMS CHANGES

Connecticut has no time to lose. The cost of youth disengaging from or never entering services is too steep. To effectively bring disconnected youth who are un- or under-served into career pipelines, the following actions require state action.

- **Target Untapped Federal Funds:** Assure that state agencies maximize revenues available from un- or under- utilized federal funding that could be targeted to support publicly- and privately administered workforce development, education and social support services for disconnected youth.
- **Shared Data Platform:** Document and achieve better outcomes for at-risk and disconnected young people by leveraging existing data platforms to provide a streamlined way for private and public providers to access and share integrated, individual-level deidentified data to improve collaboration, communication, efficiency and transparency.



There is negligible dedicated funding from the state of Connecticut to support these services for disconnected youth.

In Support of H.B. 5213: An Act Concerning Disconnected Youth

Dear Representative Currey, Senator McCrory, Representative McCarty, Senator Berthel, Representative Leeper, Senator Winfield, and members of the Education Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support H.B. 5213: An Act Concerning Disconnected Youth. My name is Rhea Henry. I currently serve as a Workforce Development Coordinator at Norwalk ACTS in Norwalk. Norwalk ACTS is a Collective Impact partnership that brings people, organizations, and systems together, in a structured way, to achieve social change.

I support H.B. 5213: An Act Concerning Disconnected Youth as I believe that this legislation addresses a critical issue facing our youth and provides much-needed support to those who find themselves disconnected from educational and employment opportunities. A recently published Dalio Education report found that, approximately 119,000 or 19% of Connecticut's 14- to 26-year-olds were either at-risk or disconnected in, and of those 119,000 approximately 63,000 are already classified as "disconnected".

In Norwalk, the disconnected youth crisis is even more dire than that of the state on average. A concerning reality in Norwalk is 28% of our youth, amounting to 1114 individuals are currently disconnected. Amongst this group, a particularly alarming trend is the presence of 242 newly disconnected youth. This crisis is highlighted among our recent Norwalk Public School graduates. An average of 29% of the last five graduating classes from Norwalk Public Schools (2018-2022), representing approximately 220 graduates each year, have not enrolled in 2 or 4-year degree colleges or universities. This statistic sheds light on a significant portion of our youth who face barriers to accessing higher education opportunities and job training opportunities that connect them to livable wage career pathways. What's particularly alarming is that 80% of these non-enrolled students are individuals of color. This stark racial disparity underscores the urgency of addressing the disconnected youth crisis, as it disproportionately affects marginalized communities.

Addressing the disconnected youth crisis not only has intrinsic value to our communities but holds immense instrumental value for the state. For instance, the potential impact on addressing this crisis is significant for our economy, given that there are more than 90,000 unfilled jobs statewide. By reengaging disconnected youth, not only could it address the workforce shortage but bolster the state's Gross Domestic Product by an estimated \$5 billion to \$5.5 billion.

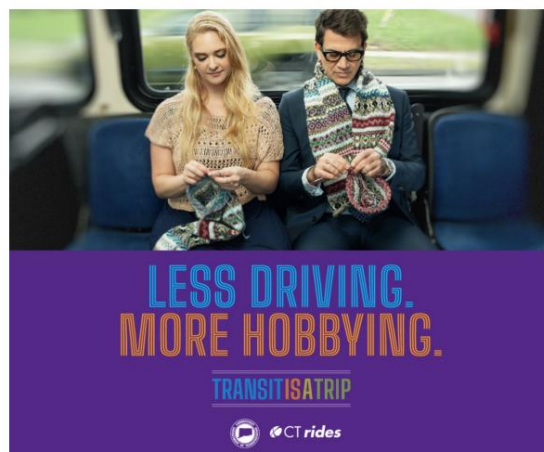

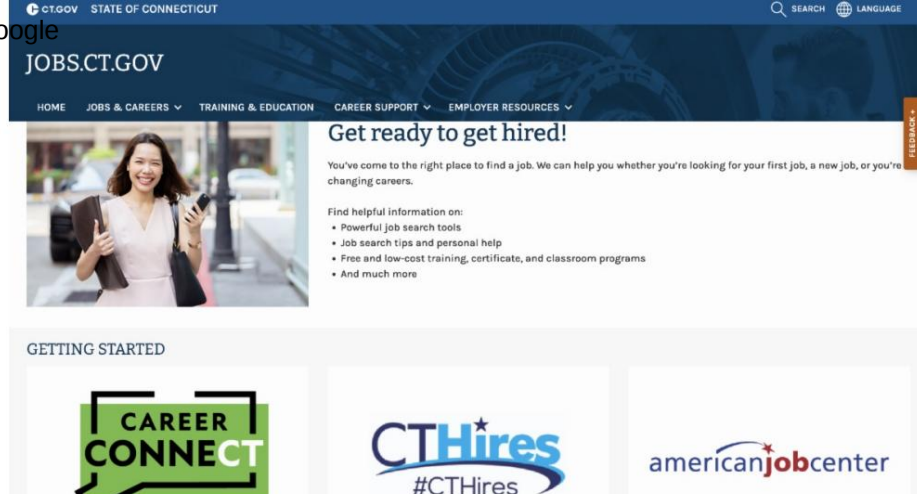

3. To complete your job posting, fill out your **payment** and credit card information.
4. Once your payment is submitted you'll received a **confirmation email** and your job posting will go live immediately.

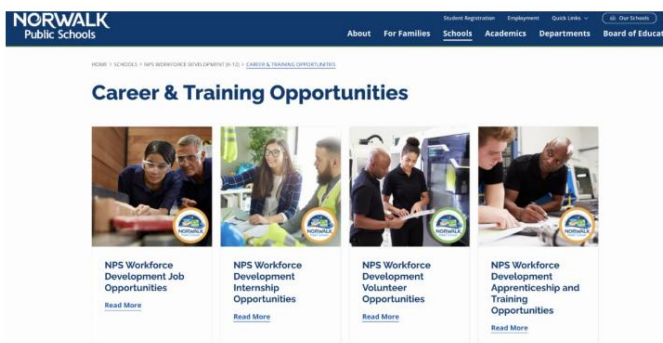

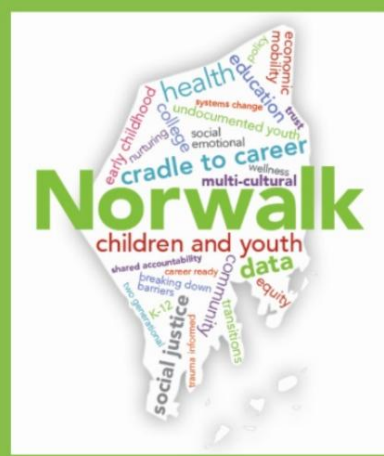
