

The Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST) is a two-day workshop designed to teach individuals how to provide a skilled intervention with a person having thoughts of suicide and how to develop a collaborative safety plan to keep someone safe and alive.

ASIST teaches the skills needed to provide crucial and timely suicide first aid help. Participants will learn how to prevent suicide by:

- Recognizing signs
- Providing a skilled intervention
- Develop a safety plan
