Terms Defined

Graduated and Left – students who earned a degree: associates, bachelors, or certificate

New to College – students who enrolled in a semester for the first time

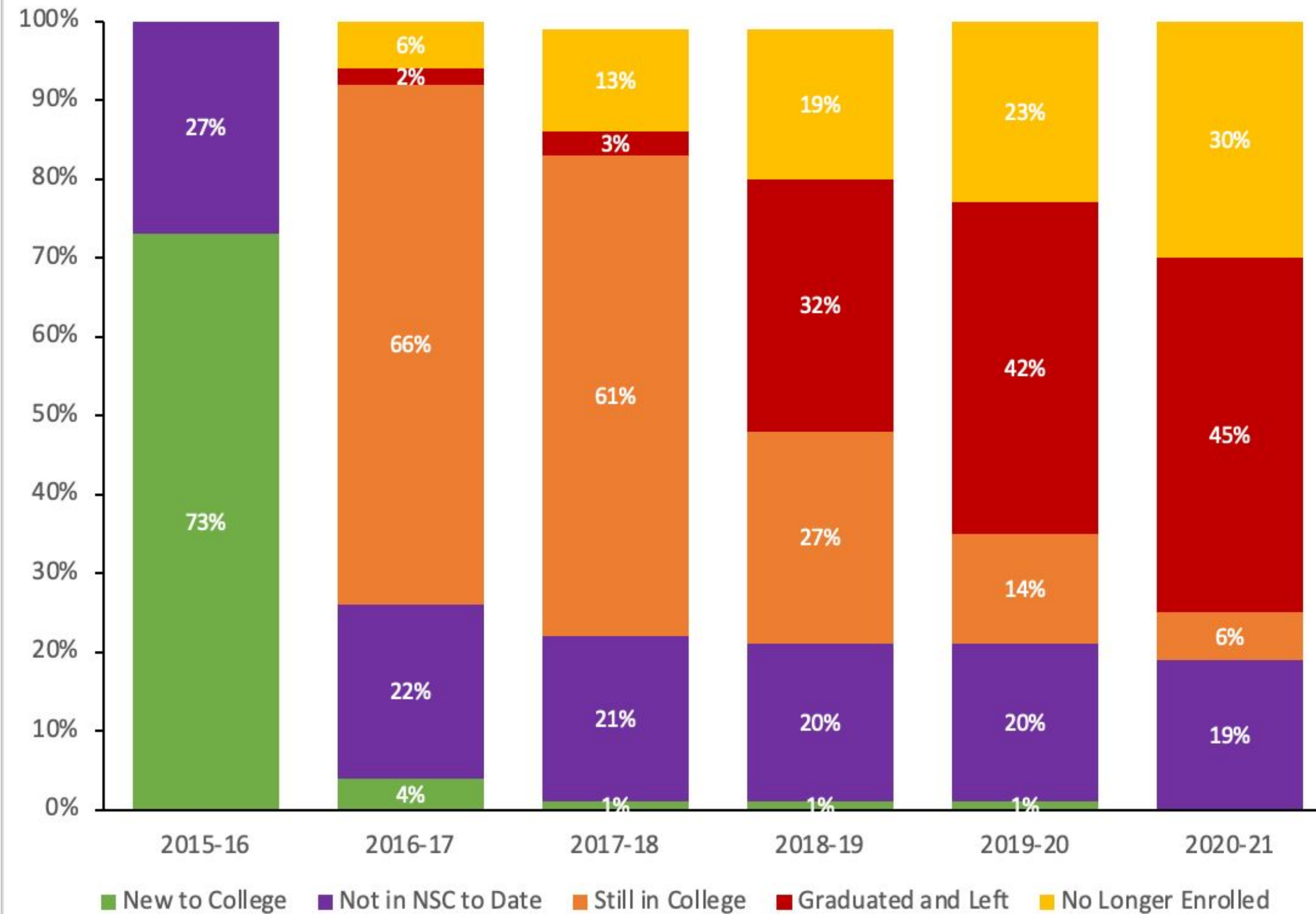
Retained – students who enrolled in a semester and then re-enrolled in the following semester

No Longer Enrolled – students who are no longer enrolled after being enrolled in a semester

Not in NSC to Date – students who are not in NSC for that school year

What happened to the Class of 2015?

Class of 2015 (n=766) Postsecondary Enrollment and Progress



- 19% of the class haven't been to college
- 30% went to college but dropped out
- 6% are still without a degree
- About 1% try college for the first time each year
- About a third (33%) graduated college in 4 years
- Almost half (45%) graduated college in 6 years
- 73% go to college in the first year

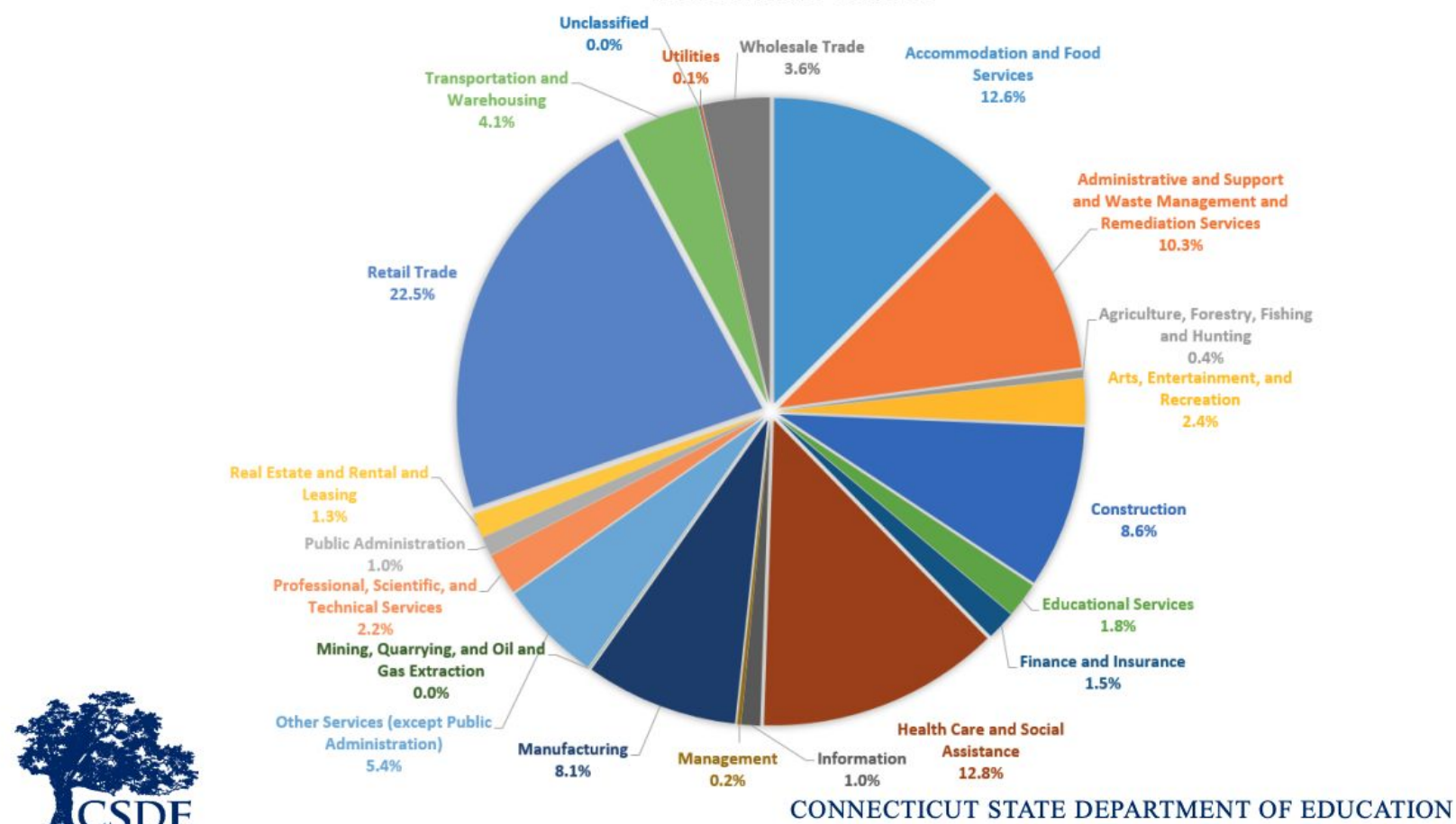
Current Thinking of Next Steps
