

Longtime Organist retiring after over 50 years of service to The Church

After more than 50 years of service to the church, organist and musical leader Vicki Fey, CCM is retiring in February.

Vicki will be retiring from her post as Organist/Music Associate from Central Presbyterian Church in historic Atlanta.

In addition to her work as an organist, Vicki has been a steady and strong influence in the Presbyterian Association of Musicians serving as Executive Board secretary as well as president. Her and her husband, Steve, have served on several conference planning committees and directed PAM's 2002 Westminster (PA) Conference on Worship and Music and the 2015 Montreat (NC) Worship and Music Conferences.

Vicki earned her Bachelor of Music degree (1976) in organ and church music from Stetson University in DeLand, Florida and a Master of Music degree (1982) from North Texas State University (now the University of North Texas) in Denton, Texas. Vicki and Steve served for 33 years as musicians in three Presbyterian churches from 1983-2017, sharing playing and directing responsibilities! They served FPC Vero Beach, Florida, FPC Kingwood, Texas, and FPC Bristol, Tennessee prior to coming to Atlanta.
