Greetings Wauwatosa Families!

The 2019 Summer School term is quickly approaching and we are excited to offer excellent programming once again.

Registration for resident enrollment will open on April 2, 2019. Below are a couple of important notes about registration.

- Registration is not first come first serve - it will remain open through the start of classes - so no need to worry about rushing to register. The Wauwatosa School District is committed to offering the classes your child is interested in and will adjust the number of classes to accommodate enrollment.
**Elementary Phy-Ed classes will be limited at East High School due to space limitations with the upcoming referendum project construction.*
- PowerSchool will be used to register your child for summer school. Detailed information regarding the process, including how to set up an account, will be sent to you at the end of March.
- Due to the rebuild of Lincoln Elementary that will be underway, Eastside JK-2 classes will be offered at Jefferson Elementary. If you have children that will need to be dropped off at Jefferson and East, don't worry! Jefferson will have playground supervision from 7:40-8:00 a.m. to accommodate the additional drop-off needs.

Information about courses, Summer School dates, hours, attendance policy, registration and more can be found in the Wauwatosa Recreation Department's 2019 Summer Activity Guide, which was recently mailed to all residents, or on our website www.wauwatosaschools.org/summerschool.

Please note a few corrections to information included in the Activity Guide:

- Under course descriptions, Jumpstart to K4 is listed. However, Jumpstart to K4 will not be offered this summer. Please speak to your child's school to find out specific details about Junior Kindergarten conferences for the fall.
