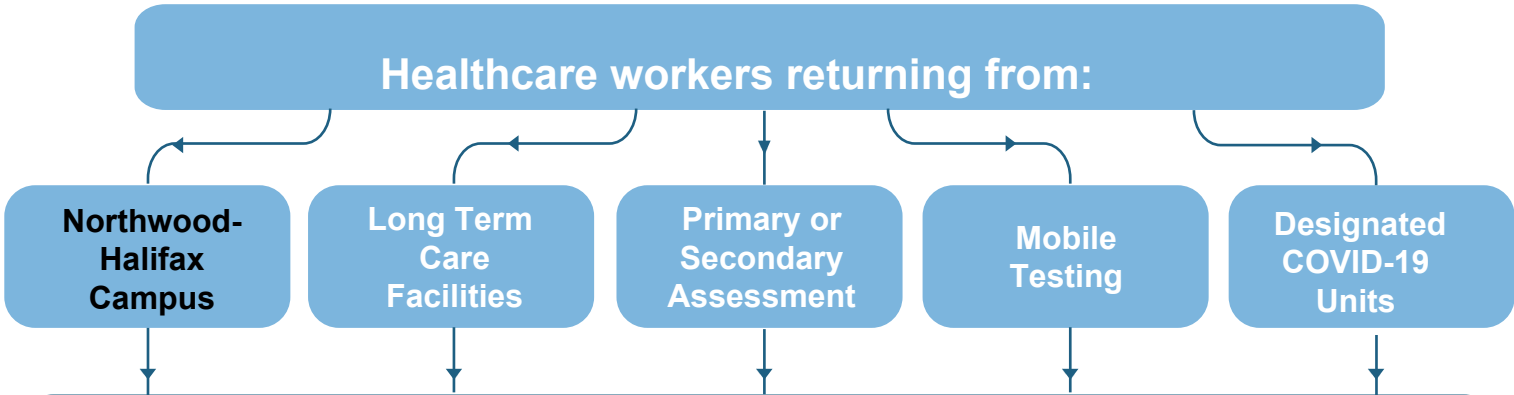


# RETURN TO WORK GUIDELINES FOR DEPLOYED STAFF



\*staff working at Northwood-Halifax CAN NOT work at other facilities

14 day isolation from last day worked & swab on day 12.

Return to Inpatient, Ambulatory or Community Care setting can occur with strict compliance to the criteria below for a period of 14 days. Swabbing at day 12 is **NOT** required for these healthcare workers

Staff **CAN NOT** return to work if they have even **ONE** of the following: **FEVER** of 37.8°C or higher, **COUGH** that is new or worsening, **SHORTNESS OF BREATH**, **SORE THROAT**, **RUNNY NOSE** or **NASAL CONJESTION**.



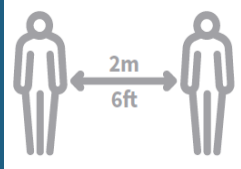
Strict adherence to twice daily active monitoring such as temperature and symptom screening



Strict adherence to masking at **ALL TIMES** while in the facility **EVEN DURING** physical distancing



Strict adherence to Infection Prevention & Control guidelines and policies



Strict adherence to physical distancing in the workplace



Contact Occupational Health Safety & Wellness if you develop any **ONE** symptom, as noted above

## Active Monitoring for Healthcare Workers

Healthcare workers in isolation and returning from deployment require **strict** adherence to active symptom monitoring. The chart below will help you identify and track symptoms for 14 days. Some symptoms of COVID-19 are subtle, it is imperative they are identified as quickly as possible

Temperature, greater than 37.8 (Y/N)

Shortness of breath (Y/N)														
Sore Throat (Y/N)														
Runny Nose (Y/N)
