I-84, South Jerome INTERCHANGE

The Idaho Transportation Department is replacing the I-84 South Jerome Interchange (Exit 168).

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Improving local roads and installing new traffic signals.
- Adding a sidewalk and bike lane to the new Lincoln Avenue bridges.

WHAT TO EXPECT IN 2025:

- Most work will occur Monday – Saturday from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Intermittent I-84 closures will be necessary for bridge work and traffic shifts. Most closures will occur at nighttime.
- Traffic shifts and ramp changes will occur.
- Local road closures will occur, and detours will be in place.
- Speed limits are reduced.



PROCESS AND SCHEDULE:

2024 Construct improvements to local roads and the westbound on-ramp. Begin bridge work and Lincoln Avenue. Construct the temporary westbound off-ramp and eastbound on- and off-ramps. Begin building new westbound off-ramp and eastbound on- and off-ramps.

2025 Complete work on the westbound and eastbound on-ramps. Complete improvements to Lincoln Avenue. Continue work on the eastbound off-ramp and bridge work.

2026 Complete the new eastbound off-ramp, bridge work, demolish the existing Lincoln Avenue bridge and complete construction.
