The Independent Redistricting Committee of Long Beach has made their final decisions regarding the redistricting for City Council representation. The Bluff Heights Neighborhood will be entirely represented by the 2nd City Council District. Up until now, Bluff Heights was split and was represented by both 2nd and 3rd Council offices.

Cindy Allen is the 2nd District Councilwoman and the Bluff Heights Neighborhood Association has already scheduled a meeting with several of our Board members to meet with her with the purposes of sharing:
