

Chromebooks and MiFis Available to Rent for Free at Long Beach Public Libraries

The Long Beach Public Library is expanding its new Tech To-Go program, which launched in April 2021. With this lending service, you can check out a Chromebook and a MiFi hotspot for free! These full-access hotspots are geared toward students, but can be used by anyone for job searching, career development, research projects, skill building, entertainment, social media, and more.

The devices are available for checkout at all Long Beach libraries, except Alamitos Neighborhood Library, which is closed for renovations. Library cardholders 18 years and older can schedule requests for devices online or by calling 562-570-7500 Tuesdays through Fridays during regular business hours. You can apply for a library card free of charge. Devices can be loaned for two weeks at a time, and parents or guardians must use their library card to check out devices for those younger than 18.
