 Level Two skiers are cautious novices who are able to do a "snow plow " (wedge) turn both ways and
are able to stop, but linking turns smoothly may be difficult. Level Two skiers may have skied once or
twice before.
Level Three
Level Three skiers are confident novices who are able to stop and make round snow plow turns on
easy beginner trails.
Level Four
 Level Four skiers are cautious intermediate skiers who can link turns but still moderate speed. Level
Four skiers ski in a small wedge and their skis may even be parallel at the end of the turn on green or
easy blue trails. Level Four is a transition level in which skiers will begin to ski more blue intermediate
runs.

Ski fittings will be scheduled at Landpark Ski and Sport on Freeport, if equipment is needed.
