**WHAT THE WORKSHOP IS ABOUT**

"Social-emotional development is the foundation for all development and is a critical determiner of success in school and life." In this workshop participants will discover and learn about initiatives such as: the Take a Minute Campaign and the Strengthening Families 5 Protective Factors, that support the role of parents in the social emotional development of their child. Through interactive activities, participants will explore ways to reinforce the critical role that parents play in this important developmental period.

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CE's - Additional fees and on-site registration required to apply for CE's.
