At trainings, Community Parents assist with setup, welcome participants and provide support to the presenter.

Duties:

- Staff monthly events, including family activities, play groups, parent trainings and outreach.
- Provide peer parent and family support by listening and using family centered service.
- Maintain confidential information; respect and protect the confidential nature of information, events, and circumstances of children and families.
- Participates in special projects, assignments and tasks as needed.

- Is a parent or family member of a child with a disability or delay
- Is familiar with the Early Start Program and Special Education
- Can work nights and weekends
- Values and respects diversity of culture, families, circumstances, and viewpoints;
- Is able to listen with compassion and be collaborative;

- Is comfortable using computers
