Are you pregnant or have you had a new baby? Come learn about your baby's development!

Researchers at the UC Davis MIND Institute on the UC Davis Medical Center campus in Sacramento are conducting an *online* longitudinal developmental screening study of infants from 6 through 24 months of age.

Who can participate?

- Parents of infants younger than 18 months old

What does the study involve?

- Completion of up to five brief *online* screening sessions until your child is 24 months old
- An in-person visit at the MIND Institute at 24 months if there are any developmental concerns about your baby.
- Families will receive \$5 reimbursement for each completed online session and \$25 for a visit to the MIND Institute

What else can be expected?

- Close tracking of your baby's development with feedback from experts
