About Brian Sussman

Brian Sussman began his high-profile San Francisco Bay Area media career in the Eighties as a television meteorologist, eventually becoming a part of the Emmy award-winning KPIX-Channel Five News Team. Simultaneously, Brian was also the designated fill-in weatherman for the nationally broadcast program, CBS This Morning in New York City. His weathercasts were awarded “Best Of” a record eighteen times by the Associated Press and the Radio-TV News Director’s Association.

In addition to his nightly weather presentations, he was the driving force behind the popular weekly televised feature, “Brian’s Kids.” Those special segments on Channel Five were designed to highlight Bay Area foster children who were eligible for adoption. Over ten-years, “Brian’s Kids” was responsible for the successful adoption of more than 400 children.

In 2001, Brian departed television to try his hand at conservative talk radio, hosting an evening show on the immensely prominent airwaves of KSFO - San Francisco. In short order he was named host the station’s highly ranked Morning Show and became a regular fill-in personality for both Mark Levin’s and Michael Savage’s syndicated programs. In 2018, the San Francisco Radio Hall of Fame honored him as “Broadcaster of the Year. He retired from radio in 2020.

Brian is the bestselling author of Climategate: A Veteran Meteorologist Exposes the Global Warming Scam (2010), Eco-Tyranny (2012), and Climate Cult: Exposing Their War on Life, Liberty, and Property (2025).

Brian remains active as a speaker, podcaster, and proprietor of BrianSussman.com.

Prop 50	State of California AUTHORIZES TEMPORARY CHANGES TO CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT MAPS IN RESPONSE TO TEXAS' PARTISAN REDISTRICTING. LEGISLATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT: Authorizes new partisan congressional district maps, drawn by Legislature, to be used in California's congressional elections through 2030	NO	• Prop 20 (2010) created independent Citizens Redistricting Commission to redistrict after each census (instead of politicians) - o 40% of CA voted for Trump in 2024 - o 17% of CA Congressmen are REPUBLICAN - o 7% of CA Congressmen would be REPUBLICAN if Prop 50 passes • Prop 50 abandons Prop 20 and alters CA Constitution to bring back gerrymandering by politicians until 2030 (conveniently after Newsom runs for POTUS in 2028) • Soros just donated \$10M to help pass it
