# Winter Toastmasters Leadership Institute Helps Build Resilience!

The Winter TLI, held virtually on Saturday, November 7<sup>th</sup>, brought 145 D103 Toastmasters club officers, members and guests together for an engaging, informative online learning experience. Keynote speaker Pat Johnson, DTM, PIP, sounded a call to action from the start with her speech titled "Resistance Reaps Resilience," in which she described behavior strategies that can help us each better thrive and be able to handle the unexpected. Participants then had a chance to attend six different educational sessions including introductory or advanced Pathways; judging speech contests; using FreeToastHost; branding online club meetings; leading a club to success; and embracing resiliency and transformation. After lunch, Pat led a solution-oriented workshop on "Building and Sustaining Vibrant Corporate and Community Clubs," sharing her experiences and insights that drew strongly on the Toastmasters Promise to resolve challenges. Club officers later were able to complete mandatory training for their respective club officer roles with the objective to finish their tenure strong and achieve goals for club success.
