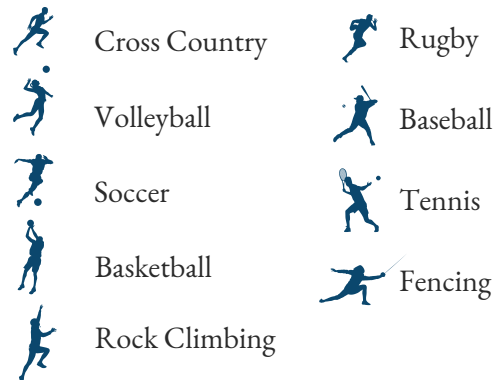
OUR FACULTY
