

Dear Parent/Guardian,

There has been a confirmed case of Streptococcal Pharyngitis (Strep Throat) at school.

*Streptococcal Pharyngitis (Strep Throat)* is a bacterial infection which causes a severe sore throat and usually accompanied by a fever, fatigue, and red swollen neck glands. The condition generally appears within 1 to 3 days after exposure to an infected person.

An individual diagnosed with *Streptococcal Pharyngitis (Strep Throat)* is excluded from school until 24 hours after administration of the antibiotic has started and fever has subsided without fever reducing medication.
