Middle School Socials are a great opportunity to spend time with your fellow classmates. Participation in socials is a privilege that can be lost if a student cannot follow the dress code or conduct expectations below.

DRESS CODE

Clothing must be modest and appropriate for wear in a Catholic school setting. Tank tops, halter-tops, midriff shirts, shorts shorter than fingertip length, or any garments exposing an inappropriate amount of a student's body are not permitted. The bottom of shirts must meet the top of pants. Undergarments may not show. Garments with advertisements for cigarettes, alcohol, or music groups may not be worn. Garments with offensive or inappropriate language, graphics, or symbols may not be worn. Hats/caps are not worn indoors. Blue jeans may not be frayed, tattered, too tight or too baggy. Shoes should be appropriate for wear on the gym floor.

Anyone violating the dress code will be asked to call his/her parents to bring proper attire.

CONDUCT

School expectations for conduct and behavior apply during Middle School Socials. Students are expected to follow the school wide discipline plan - be respectful, be responsible, and be safe. More specifically students are expected to:

- throw away trash, clean up spills, and take care of themselves;
- respect school property, equipment, and one another;
- refrain from fighting, throwing objects at others, name calling, or use of inappropriate language;
- remain in the gym until a parent or adult acting on behalf of the parent signs the student out. Once signed out, a student may not return;
- walk unless involved in a sports activity or game that requires running.

If chaperones have difficulty with students and their conduct, the student will be asked to sit out for a period of time. If difficulties continue or a serious incident occurs, a student's parents will be called and asked to pick up the student immediately. In addition, a report will be given to school administration who, will determine if further consequences or disciplinary action is needed.

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
