- ♦ The cost for each summer program is \$150/student per camp.
- ♦ Sacred Art camps have an additional materials fee of \$50/student.
- → Students may be dropped off and picked up at the Cathedral High School main entrance (Westview) beginning 15 minutes before each program begins. Please follow carpool line procedures by entering the lot from the Shadyvilla side and driving around the side of the school to drop-off/pick up in front of the main entrance on Westview. Please do not block traffic turning into the lot from Westview Dr. Students must be picked up within 15 minutes of the camp end time, or families will be charged for extended care.
- High-school aged students remaining the whole day between programs should bring lunch, and will be encouraged to attend noon Mass.
