What to Wear

Students should wear a **t-shirt in their grade's assigned color (listed below)** with **schoolappropriate shorts.**

- Shorts must extend to at least fingertip length (applies to both boys and girls) when arms are at the side—this includes running shorts and tennis skirts.
- Athletic tennis shoes are required. No flip flops, sandals, Crocs, Hey Dudes, or Sperrys allowed.
- Please apply sunscreen and/or bug spray at home before arrival. Staff will not apply these at school.
