Adventures in Collage - Come explore different ways to make collages in "Adventures in Collage!" Each day we'll focus on a new theme and make a collage based on that topic. Expect to make art about your favorite food, about color, and more. By the end of the week you will get to take home lots of artwork that shows off what paper and glue can do.

Colored Pencil Workshop - Colored pencils are one of the best mediums for detailed artwork, allowing precision and control of detail. Students will explore different techniques, such as blending colors, layering, and burnishing to create realistic works of art. Due to its ease of use and portability, this course is a must for the artist on the go!

Painted Cardboard Sculpture - Young artists will be creating 3D Art sculptures using a variety of materials including cardboard, other paper products, and paint. We'll be exploring different textures, shapes, forms and color to build fantastic and imaginative sculptures. Join the fun!

Watercolor Pencil Workshop - Looking for a fun and convenient way to create watercolor artwork? Watercolor pencils are a unique medium that combine the best parts of both pencils and watercolors. In this course, students will learn the basics as well as tips and tricks for a variety of watercolor pencil effects. Everyone is welcome - whether you're a beginner or an experienced artist!

Paint, Paint, and more Paint - Young artists will be exploring different types of paint and learning a variety of painting techniques to create an exciting series of art works. We'll work with traditional media, such as watercolors and tempera paint, and then get a little crazy with nontraditional methods, like painting with bubbles! Come ready to have a good time!

Wet 'N Wild Watercolor - In this class students will learn a variety of techniques, such as marks, washes, spattering, stenciling, wet-in-wet and many more to create paintings. Come experiment with using watercolor with other materials like salt, alcohol, plastic wrap, sponges, graphite, and acrylic for a creative and fun experience!

Exploring the World's Great Artists I - Young artists will explore and create with fun media techniques while learning about four famous master artists: Vincent Van Gogh, Wassily Kandinsky, Claude Monet, and Henri Matisse. Enjoy painting, collage, monoprints, and colored pencils with a bit of art history knowledge and art techniques they will want to use again and again!

Prints and Papers II - Students will extend their printmaking experience and use hand tools to carve designs into a matrix for relief printing. Students will discover new materials to print on, including hand-made papers. No pre-requisite is required, this may be taken as the beginning class. Come ready for another round of messy art-making fun!

Spontaneous Composition - Jazz Improvisation Skills. From beginner musician to advanced, the class will explore how the brain hears a melody and transfers that musical thought into the electrical impulses to trigger the body and execute this melody into a music instrument. Learn memorization and motivic development of a single new melody and learn how to improvise "on the fly" during a jazz performance.

The Woodlands Jazz Project - Ensemble Skills. Students will learn and perform from the many types of styles associated with jazz. Early blues melodies are followed by Big Band Era swing, then into fusion and modern jazz all with opportunities to be expressive and use improvisation skills. Emphasis is placed on style, proper articulation, balance and harmonization understanding the proper use of tone inflection.

Mixed Media Collage - Young artists will be using different materials and techniques to create a mixed media collage. We'll be exploring with such materials as textured paper, splatter paint, and stamps, and having adventures with fun techniques such as tape transfers and experimental brushing techniques. Don't miss this one!

Animal Mania (repeat) - If you love animals and art, then this class is for you! In this multi-media class, campers will create artworks inspired by their favorite animals, both near and far, while learning about the elements of art. Mural Painting - Students will work with Houston based artists Kenneth Pierson and Corella Fairchild, co-owners of KP & Corie Art. The couple will co-teach rendering designs in Adobe Suite software, and the techniques and processes for executing a finished mural. The end result will be a beautiful mural for The Woodlands Children Museum—a win-win for students and the community!

Paper Passion - Endless possibilities for such a simple medium! Campers will have fun making textured papers to create beautiful paper mosaics, paper "glass" and cut paper sculptures, all while learning about the elements of art and principles of design.

Drawing with Charcoal - Come discover the excitement of Drawing with Charcoal! Students will create detailed compositions as they learn to realistically depict light and shadows on still life objects and portraits with a variety of charcoal media.

Exploring the World's Great Artists II - We're back! In this series, we will be learning the history and techniques of Jim Dine, Piet Mondrian, Georgia O'Keeffe and Pablo Picasso. Artists will enjoy creating with soft pastels, textured glue, collage, painting, and oil pastels. Artist should come prepared to get their hands dirty and their heart filled with love for art! Please note, part I is not a pre-requisite of this class.
