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## Weaknesses

1. Subcommittee structure & accessibility.
2. Resource allocation and partner capacity.
3. Publicity.
4. Community involvement.
5. Meeting engagement and format.

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## Opportunities

1. Grant funding.
2. Meeting locations.
3. Community engagement and collaboration.
4. Communication improvements.
5. Educational programs and opportunities.

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## Threats

1. Organizational overlap and competition.
2. Funding challenges.
3. Media considerations and data sharing issues.
4. Current federal/state administration.

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## SWOT Analysis Take Aways

- 1. Review how to access LWPC information more regularly.**
- 2. Dismantle current subcommittees and rebuild based on member's overlapping goals/objectives with health equity at the center.**
  - A. Include marketing/publicity subcommittee to develop marketing plan
  - B. Consider CHD's CHIP and CoC's Thriving Neighborhoods.
- 3. Restructure meeting schedules to boost subcommittee action.**
  - A. Members commit to one subcommittee for a set timeframe.
  - B. Bi-monthly/quarterly LWPC meetings with Bi-monthly/monthly subcommittee meetings.
  - C. Each subcommittee will have action items and report out.
