## **Leadership Development Team Educational Opportunity – Fall 2019**

**WHAT?** The Leadership Development Team will pilot a course in the fall of 2019 that will utilize online learning modules available through the Internet. It will entail one face-to-face, group meeting at the beginning of the course and one meeting at the end of the course. This will be a **four lesson course titled “Introduction to Theological Studies – Building Your Theology.”**

**WHO?** Pastors, ministry staff, and those in the church who simply want to increase their biblical and theological knowledge and understanding. **Completion of the course will count for 5 Equipping Units for those who have received recording of ordination.**

**WHY?** Quality online courses are available over the Internet, but many find it difficult to maintain motivation to complete them, sense a lack of interaction to process the information, desire to find relevance to ministry, and wish for significant evaluation. A cohort will be established to kick off the course and to wrap it up, giving encouragement, assistance as needed, accountability, and structure.

**WHEN?** First meeting: Thursday, September 19 7:00 – 9:00 pm at the Evangelical Friends Headquarters  
Second meeting: Thursday, October 24 7:00 – 9:00 pm at the Evangelical Friends Headquarters  
At the first meeting the course will be introduced, all the components explained, goals of the course will be clarified, suggestions given on how it is to be completed, and instruction given on how to download and use the material.

**COST?** \$25 to join us for this course

**BENEFITS?** No textbooks to purchase. All is done at your own pace on your own time schedule, in your own home or office.

**PLATFORM?** Third Millennium Curriculum – seminary level courses, taught by teachers and seminary professors from accredited seminaries. All are committed Evangelical Christians. Their statement of faith is in agreement with Evangelical Friends.

Each lesson has:

- A lesson given by a noted theologian. It is available in three formats: video, audio, text, and can be downloaded. The video is about 90 minutes
- A forum, consisting of relevant questions about the topic, also available in the three formats: video, audio, text. It is also about 90 minutes in length.
- Outline and study guide for taking notes
- Additional basic information, a glossary, and additional required reading – all provided online
- Essay and journal questions
- Quizzes over each section – with certificates to print when passing with 70% or more
- An optional learning game (such as a crossword puzzle or hangman game)
- An optional creative expression suggestion
- An accumulative test for each lesson and a final test at the end of the course
- A way to track your progress online
