

# **“Pathways Forward” Packet Updated\***

## **January 31, 2020**

### **A. Choice categories:**

1. HCCC – 3 options:
  - a. College Now Sophomores
  - b. Present Juniors
  - c. Any other Marist student
2. 21 Catholic Schools:
  - a. 7 Local schools: all are Healthy; I’ve met the Principals; Tuition agreements explained
  - b. 14 Other Catholic Schools – NJ and NY (\*NYC schools included in this update)
3. 6 Charters:
  - a. BelovED Charter – Freshmen (rising Sophomores) only
  - b. Other Charter Schools – Newark and JC (\*METS is included in this update)
4. County Schools – Marist does not have an agreement in place, yet.

### **B. Financial Considerations**

1. SFIC and SPA will follow Catholic Schools in the Newark Archdiocese. Must reapply for SFIC.
2. For all Catholic Schools, plan to reapply for FACTs Financial Aid; Be prepared to pay the \$35 fee.
3. Each school has a different way of approaching tuition; for example:
  - a. In most cases, fees will not be discounted; only the tuition.
  - b. Varying Scenarios:
    - i. Pay what you paid at Marist (present your invoice which will be mailed on 2/6)
    - ii. Pay what you paid at Marist for first year
    - iii. Pay what you paid at Marist for first year and then a percentage increase in future years
    - iv. They will re-evaluate financial aid against their criteria
    - v. They will re-evaluate scholarship against their criteria
4. A sample invoice has been attached as the last page of this packet. Use it to help you interpret your invoice, which will be mailed to you on February 6 with the report card and an unofficial transcript.

#### **E. Athletics: Word to the Wise**

NJSIAA ruling: Due to a school closing, the NJSIAA allows any transferring student/athlete who **completes the entire year** at their present school to be immediately eligible in any sport regardless if he or she has participated on a varsity level. However, if a student/athlete **transfers during the school year** and has participated on the varsity level, the thirty (30) day sit out period would apply for each sport in which the student played at the varsity level.
