

## SPS COVID-19 Guidelines 2022-2023 "Launching Into Healthy Learning"

Examples of COVID -19 Symptoms:  Fever or chills Cough Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Fatigue Muscle or body aches Headache Loss of taste or smell Sore throat Congestion or runny nose Nausea or vomiting Diarrhea
Individuals with COVID -19 symptoms do not fall into the Test-Mask and Go strategy should:  Isolate at home. Get tested for COVID-19 with a PCR, antigen, or home test as soon as possible. Avoid activities outside of home. If the COVID-19 test is negative, and after symptoms improve, including being fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication, may return to work/school.

C.Tested Positive for COVID-19 (Regardless of vaccination status)	D. Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 and are symptom free. (Regardless of vaccination status)
<ul> <li>Received a positive COVID-19 test result</li> <li>Isolate at home for 5 days.</li> <li>Return to work/school on day 6 if you are feeling well,symptoms have significantly improved and are fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.</li> <li>Upon returning to work/school, wear a mask for an additional 5 days. If a mask can not be worn a 10 day isolation period is required.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Continue to report to work and attend school.</li> <li>Take a COVID-19 test 5 days after exposure.</li> <li>If the COVID-19 test result is negative, continue to report to work and attend school.</li> <li>Wear a mask at all times around others for 10 days and monitor for symptoms.</li> </ul>

## E. School Outbreaks / High Risk Classroom Exposure to COVID-19 case/cases (Regardless of vaccination status)

- SPS will notify CT DPH and Stratford Health Department to determine appropriate course of action when there are multiple positive cases in a school or a specific classroom.
- Quarantine, isolation, contact tracing and COVID-19 testing may be required.
