This will be a public show, there are a few guidelines we must follow:

- Videos should be recorded horizontally (landscape).
- All lyrics/content are subject to approval.
- Due to time restrictions, students are limited to two acts.
- All students Pre-K 3 through Grade 8 are invited to participate.

While it isn't what we imagined Variety Show 2020 to look like, we are happy to give our students an opportunity to shine.
