- Student eligibility requirements:

  - o Has 90% attendance up to end of 3rd quarter (March 8, 2018)
  - o Is passing all classes for the year-to-date average for all classes at a minimum of 60% as of the end of the 3rd quarter (March 8, 2018)





- Total Cost: \$300/ includes camp fees, transportation, lodging and food
- Deposit: \$100 begin accepting Oct. 30, 2017, limited space so commit early
  - Final date to hold spot November 17, 2018

Hop into Habitats - Diversity, needs for survival, populations, and competition are discovered by comparing coastal communities.

## Tax Credit Dollars and the FHMS Camp Surf Trip

Dear Parents, Guardians and Community Members,

All Arizonans can provide significant financial support to our students and it does not cost them even a dollar. The State of Arizona offers state tax payers a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for contributions made to schools. This is a true tax credit, not a deduction. The amount donated comes right off of the taxpayer's bill at the time income taxes are filed. Individual tax payers can contribute up to \$200 and married couples can contribute up to \$400. Tax credit donations can be given to one student group or can be split among many at the taxpayer's discretion.

The trip to Camp Surf qualifies as a tax credit. The club name is:
