For the last several years there has been a group of women who have met to study God's Word together on Monday mornings. We would like to invite you to join us this fall for a book study. (Please keep in mind that there is no nursery however for this activity.)

Although there are many hindrances to meeting for a study as we have in the past, we are looking forward to what we **CAN** do! After much prayer and consideration of our particular group of women, some who have specific health vulnerabilities and/or provide care for those who do, we have decided upon a plan. We will also hold these plans loosely- meaning, we recognize adjustments may have to be made as circumstances change. But meeting together is such a necessary thing, don't you agree? It is our hope that by setting these parameters in place, those who have been **isolated** (unable to attend most things) will be able to join us for fellowship and study.

1. We will meet on Monday mornings, beginning on **September 14th, outdoors** under the covered portico in the front of the church. We will have chairs set up (within social distancing guidelines). If weather becomes an issue, we will move into the sanctuary and would recommend wearing masks so be prepared. (per CDC guidelines)
2. We will only meet for **one hour** and begin at an earlier time due to morning temperatures outside. **(9:30-10:30)** (This could be adjusted back to our original start time of 10:00 when the weather changes.)
3. We will discuss the book **None Like Him: 10 Ways God is Different From Us (and why that's a good thing)** by Jen Wilken. During this time of uncertainty in our world/culture, how good would it be to intentionally focus upon the CERTAINTY of who our GOD IS?!? This will be a 10 week study ending around Thanksgiving.
