Rite of Ordination

Calling of the Candidate

(Rev. Jane Reina will present the candidate, Dcn Rosean Amaral, to be ordained. +Bishop Kae will call on representatives from Dcn Rosean's discernment team, the Rocky Mountain ECC, Leadership Council and family to attest to her calling.)

Election by the People: Mary of Magdala ECC

+Kae:And so, I ask you all now. Is it your will that Rosean Amaral be ordained a priest for the ECC to serve within your community? **All:** Yes.

+Kae: Will you support and uphold her in this ministry? **All:** Yes

+Kae: Rosean, is it your intention and desire to serve the body of Christ as a priest?

Rosean: Yes, it is. I am ready and willing.

+ Kae: May God, who has begun this good work, bring it to fulfillment. **All:** *Thanks be to God.*

Homily

Meditation Song: Here I Am, Lord (All join in singing)

1. I, the Lord of sea and sky, I have heard my people cry. All who dwell in dark and sin My hand will save.

Promises of the Elect

(After the meditation song, Deacon Rosean rises and stands before the bishop who questions her. The altar area is then prepared and witnesses arrive. The prostration cloth and chairs are prepared.)

Litany of the saints (Join in singing)

God have mercy
Christ have mercy

All: God have mercy

..... All: All you holy men and women, pray for us.

Laying On of Hands

(After the prostration, the bishop stands to one side and lays hands on the head of Rosean and inaudibly asks the Holy Spirit to send blessing upon Rosean Amaral.)

(All the priests present lay hands on Rosean for their blessing.)

Prayer of Ordination +Kae

(At the conclusion)We pray through Jesus Christ, your Son who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the holy Spirit one God forever and ever. **All: Amen**

Investiture and Anointing

(Rosean places her joined hands between those of +Bishop Kae. The bishop then anoints the palms of the our new priest with holy chrism and says:)

+Kae: May the Lord Jesus Christ whom God anointed with the power of the Holy Spirit, guard and preserve you, that you may sanctify the Beloved and give glory to God!"

(+Kae presents Mother Rosean a bible, chalice and paten as signs of the authority given to preach the word of God and to administer holy sacraments.)
