

A Message from Rocky Mountain Region of the Ecumenical Catholic Communion:

Thank you again for joining in our Regional celebration.

Unfortunately due diligence necessitates this alert.

As of today, 2 people have tested positive for COVID-19 and another has reported COVID symptoms and is being tested today. All three participated actively in liturgy and stayed for the reception following the ceremony. With the small numbers it is not possible to determine if the source of the exposure was the Consecration, however it is a distinct possibility.

Thus, if you attended the Consecration on Sept 19, please:

- Get tested for COVID-19 as soon as possible. Even if you were vaccinated, you can catch and spread the Delta variant whether or not you are symptomatic.
- Continue to monitor yourself through October 2 in relation to this event. If you experience symptoms of COVID 19, get tested again
- Until you receive test results, take extra care not to spread the virus to others. Wear a mask, properly, a good one. Double mask if possible. Distance. Wash hands. Stay home.
- 4. If you test positive for COVID 19 between today and October 2 please respond to this email, or contact Don. Alice Bradley at <u>alice.bradley@ucdenver.edu</u>. Your identity will remain confidential; you are not required to inform us, however, your willingness to do so will help us protect our communities throughout the region and beyond.
