

## Safety Protocols within the sanctuary

- 1. Altar and other surfaces used will be cleaned prior to the service
- 2. Hosts have been purchased from the Benedictine Monastery prior to the Covid-19 outbreak.
- 3. All doors will be open during the service to circulate air.
- 4. No more than 10 people will be in the sanctuary, all will wear protective masks and socially distance. Pastor Jane will remove her mask to speak.
- 5. Communion hosts will remain in ciborium (cup) covered until distributed.

## Safety protocols for distribution of communion

- 1. Distribution will be outside the building.
- 2. Only Hosts will be distributed for communion.
- 3. Hand sanitizer will be used in between encounter with communicant if a sense of contact is made
- 4. Communicants are asked to wear masks when accepting the host.
- 5. Communicants will proceed to building main entrance by approaching on the right side of the walkway, exiting on the left.
- 6. For those who would like to remain in their car to have communion brought to them, please pull up to the handicap parking space just in front of the main entrance.
- 7. Tape will be on the sidewalk to designate social distancing if a line is formed.
