## Safety Protocols for Sanctuary

- 1. All attending and assisting with the service will wear masks and use hand sanitizer before entering and exiting the church.
- 2. Please enter via the Northside door (closest to the MoM office.) Front sliding doors to remain closed. We will have all doors leading into the sanctuary open so fewer surfaces are touched. While sitting in the sanctuary, please choose one place to sit so it can be cleaned at the end of the service. Maintain social distance.
- 3. If a restroom is needed, please have only one individual in the restroom at a time. Use only the ones closest to the sanctuary. We will wipe down all surfaces, touch points and handles at the end of the service.
- 4. All hosts to be distributed for communion will remain in a covered ciborium. Gloves will be used to place hosts in ciborium. Hosts have been purchased or bread made prior to March 2020.
- 5. All altar, sacristy items, tables etc. used during the service must be cleaned before and after the service.

## Safety protocols for distribution of communion

- 1. Entrance to receive communion will be via the west entrance to avoid any congestion. (see below)
- Distribution of communion hosts will be via drive-up at the main entrance. Everyone is to remain in their cars to have communion brought to them.
- Hand sanitizer will be used in between encounter with communicant if a sense of contact is made.
- 4. Pastor Jane (and other eucharistic minister) will wear a mask during distribution.
- 5. Communicants are asked to wear masks when accepting the host. Hosts will be available to both sides of a vehicle.

And as always, please remain at home if you are feeling ill, have a fever or any symptoms of cold or flu.
