

NEWCOMER YOUTH WINTER DRIVE

Each year, ISAAC works with Poudre School District to provide a hygiene bag and full winter gear to the **100+ recently arrived immigrant and refugee youth** in our school district. **Middle and High School youth** in the PSD Newcomer Program come from a number of backgrounds. They are the children of immigrant workers, asylum seekers, refugees and CSU students. Many youth are also unaccompanied migrant minors fleeing dangerous home country conditions.

Teens arrive with very few resources and are not prepared for their first Colorado winter. They struggle to buy new clothes or basic hygiene items like body wash, deodorant, feminine products and shampoo.

What is Needed:

NEW WINTER GEAR (ages 12-19)

- New gear only; dark color coats preferred
- Winter hats + gloves (all sizes and colors)
- YOUTH COATS size 12, 14, 16 // ADULT COATS size S, M, L



TEEN HYGIENE PRODUCTS (male, female, gender neutral)

- Regular sized shampoo, conditioner, body wash, lotion, razors, deodorant, a brush or comb, and a toothbrush, floss and toothpaste.
