Real Time Crime Center

- Assisted patrol and detectives in over 4,000 cases
- Data-informed deployment of 70 county-owned & 82 privately-owned FLOCK Automated License Plate Reader Cameras
- RTCC Commander Captain Hudson Bull named to International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) 40 under 40 VIP List
- Real time command access to Body-Worn Cameras in the field

- Hosted quarterly conversations with Mosques and Synagogues
- Reconfigured 700 lethal shotguns to 700 bean-sock less than lethal
- Continued agency-wide annual training for Integrating Communications Assessment & Tactics (ICAT), Active Bystander for Law Enforcement (ABLE) and Priorities of Life
- Deployed 93 Hybrid Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles realizing a 39% reduction in fuel costs

- 33% of new hires fluent in multiple languages / 14 different languages spoken
- Women represent the police recruit academy classes hired since 2021 at a rate of 27%
- Historically underrepresented groups now account for 33% of command staff
- Police applicants increased by 10%
- Child Exploitation Squad investigated record 766 cyber tips
- Victim Services Division served record 3,342 victims and witnesses of violent crime
- Homicide Cold Case Squad continued to close cases pursuant to DNA genetic genealogy research indicators
