Export Controls Under International Traffic in Arms (ITAR) & the Export Administration Regulations (EAR) with a focus on changes in 2017!

Export controls and compliance with the regulations has long been a complex issue for exporters. Determining agency jurisdiction and classification under the appropriate regulations is difficult and requires a comprehensive understanding of the regulations.

The classification and compliance process has only become more complex under various new regulations and interpretations. Noncompliance can be costly and even lead to loss of export privileges.

This program will; help you identify what has changed and the steps necessary to be in full compliance. Through a review of the regulations as they currently exist and provide examples the participant will gain an understanding of how to navigate the ITAR & EAR, properly classifying their exports and obtaining the necessary Licensing and permission to export. They will learn about the new license procedures and other changes.
