A Field Operations Maintenance Person performs field data collection, maintenance tasks, and construction work throughout the water and wastewater facilities of the District. Routine duties include meter reading, building maintenance, operating and maintaining valves/pumps in sewer pumping stations, sewer pipe cleaning, installation and repair of water lines and hydrants using backhoes and hydro excavators, flagging, and erosion control work.
