# WHAT IS SUMMER SENSATIONS?

Summer Sensations, offered by the Ramsey Community School, is a morning enrichment program designed for children entering Kindergarten to 5th grade in the upcoming school year. Our goal is to extend your child's learning with exciting, educational workshops taught in an informal summertime atmosphere. Workshops are designed to stimulate creative thinking while integrating science, technology, math, reading, music, art and other skills. Children will build skills and explore their special interests in workshops of their choice, designed and taught by teaching professionals. From 9:00 am to 12:30 pm, five days a week, your child will have a unique opportunity to learn and have fun at the same time. Don't miss this opportunity to do something special and affordable for your child this summer!

**Summer Sensations offers three, 1-week sessions, Monday to Friday in July. Your child may attend for one, two or all three weeks, attending any weeks of your choice.**

- **9:00 am:** Children arrive and meet their first workshop teacher in the gym.
- **9:10 - 10:25 am: 1st WORKSHOP MEETS:** Children participate in their first workshop of the day. For 5 days the teacher will engage and stimulate creative thinking with many unique and exciting educational activities centered on the workshop theme.
- **10:25 - 11:00 am: SNACK/PLAY PERIOD:** Children participate in a refreshment/play period. Refreshments are provided by the program and include choices of snacks and bottled water.
- **11:00 am – 12:15 pm: 2nd WORKSHOP MEETS:** Children participate in their second workshop of the day.
- **12:15 - 12:30 pm:** Children meet in the gym and are escorted outside for dismissal.

**ADDITIONAL FEES:** Some classes may require an additional materials fee. Please see the individual class descriptions for this information and amount.

**DEPOSIT:** You may pay in full at the time of registration or leave a NON-REFUNDABLE \$100 deposit.

**BALANCE DUE:** May 31, 2019

**Enrollment in Summer Sensations is limited. In order to ensure your child's registration, any registration balances are due no later than this date. For registrations received on or after May 11, tuition is due in full.**

**SCHEDULE CHANGE:** One schedule change is allotted per student. Additional schedule changes will incur a \$20 processing fee for each schedule change per student including change in weeks or transfer of classes. No transfers permitted after registration deadline.

**REFUND POLICY:** Prior to May 31, tuition will be refunded, less the non-refundable deposit. On or after May 31, tuition is non-refundable for any reason.

## FAQs

### **WHAT IS THE DROP OFF & PICK UP PROCEDURE / TIMES?**

**Drop off time: 9:00 am**

**Pick up time: 12:20 pm**

Every day upon arrival, children will enter the gym and line up by their workshop name where they will meet their first workshop teacher. At the end of the day, the children are escorted to the gym and then escorted outside for dismissal by their second workshop teacher, remaining in their workshop group until they are picked up. Parents may remain in their car, taking their turn in line to pick up their child or park in the lot and walk in to collect their child personally.

### **WHO CAN REGISTER?**

Any child entering Kindergarten to 5th grade in the upcoming school year.

### **WHERE DOES IT TAKE PLACE?**

At Tisdale Elementary School, 200 Island Ave, Ramsey, NJ. Please note that not all of the classrooms are air-conditioned.

### **WHO TEACHES THE WORKSHOPS?**

Each workshop is taught by a certified teacher who has designed a workshop based on his/her individual creativity, special interests, talent and abilities. Their enthusiasm for their workshops is contagious.

### **WHAT IS THE MAXIMUM ENROLLMENT?**

To ensure high levels of participation and interaction for each child, enrollment is limited to 14 students per workshop for regular workshops.

## FAQs (CONT'D)

### WHAT ARE THE SPECIALTY WORKSHOPS AT SUMMER SENSATIONS?

In addition to the regular enrichment workshops offered at Summer Sensations, there are specialty workshops described on later pages. These workshops are part of the Summer Sensations Camp and run in conjunction with the other enrichment workshops.

- **KINDERGARTEN KIDS**

For children entering Kindergarten this coming fall. Details on page 10.

- **LET YOUR LITERACY GROW**

For children entering 1st to 5th grade this coming fall, who could use some reading / writing support during the summer. Details on page 9.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

**AIDES:** If a child requires an aide (either one-on-one or shared) during the school year (prior year or upcoming year), an aide must be present during camp as well. Summer Sensations cannot supply aides for children who require support. It is the parents' responsibility to make these arrangements. Aides must meet Ramsey School District aide requirements.

**ATTIRE:** Arts and crafts are fun...and messy! Please send your child to camp dressed casually, as they will be working with paint and glue that may stain. For your child's safety, no flip flops please.

**ATTENDANCE:** If your child will be absent from camp, please call the camp nurse at 201-785-2336 x 23515 to notify of the date of the absence.

**EXTREME WEATHER:** Please note that not all classrooms are air-conditioned. On hot days, students may stay in air conditioned rooms for recess and watch either a G or PG rated movie. RCS reserves the right to cancel classes any day(s) necessary due to weather conditions such as extreme heat advisories or severe weather. No refunds would be available for cancelled days.

**HEALTH FORM:** Please complete and submit the health form at the time of registration or soon after if registering by phone. Your child's registration is not complete without it. Please note that it is not necessary for a doctor to complete the form; parents can complete it themselves. If medication (inhaler, Epi-Pen, etc.) is required, we will provide you with a medical form that must be completed by your child's doctor. This additional medical form must accompany the medication and be brought to the camp nurse on the first day that the child attends camp.

**LATE ARRIVALS:** If your child arrives late to camp, please walk him/her to the nurse's office to check in.

**SNACKS:** Refreshments are provided by the program and include choices of snacks and bottled water. Please be sure to advise us of any food allergies on the health form at the time of registration. Students with food allergies may bring their own snacks.

## LET YOUR LITERACY GROW... READ, WRITE, REACH!

**GRADE LEVEL:** Entering 1st-5th grade next fall

**OPTIONS:** 3-Week Registration Required

**9:10 am:** Grades 1,2

**11:00 am:** Grades 3,4,5

Let Your Literacy Grow Workshops are designed to support struggling or reluctant readers and writers through a variety of reading and writing experiences in order to help them develop into independent readers and writers. Research shows that good readers enjoy the experience of reading. A balanced approach to literacy instruction begins with creating a genuine appreciation for good literature.

The goals of this workshop are to provide varied instructional activities to enable children to move to higher levels of reading and literacy development. Activities include:



- Direct phonics instruction, including focusing on individual sounds, using sounds to build words, and using words to construct sentences.
- Reading comprehension strategies, including making predictions and connections, vocabulary development, inferencing, asking questions, summarizing, and determining cause and effect.
- Written responses to literature.

Workshops are taught in a small, supportive environment of no more than 6 children, providing extensive opportunities for children to enjoy the pleasure of being good readers!

### **This year's theme: Dive into Reading**

Take to the open waters where we will read about ocean animals and work on sea based activities. We will set sail across the oceans as we develop comprehension skills such as making predictions, making connections, vocabulary development, inferencing, asking questions, summarizing and determining cause and effect.

Designed as a precursor for children entering Kindergarten next fall, the activities and approaches in the Kindergarten Kids workshop will include:

- Art & Music
- Letter Recognition
- Math Readiness
- Social Skills & Interaction
- Gross & Fine Motor Skills
- School Readiness
- Whole Group Learning

Kindergarten Kids is the place where your day begins, as we open the door and read books like never before. You will meet two different teachers and spend time with each. Is it cool to be an explorer, scientist or detective? You bet! Let's do it, as we investigate the alphabet. Art is awesome, singing is fun, and musical games can be played by everyone. Guess what! At camp, you'll make many friends anew, some may even be in school next year with you. At Summer Sensations the time will simply fly away, until you come back the very next day!

- This is an all-inclusive program.
- Children will attend camp from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm and will not be integrated with the older children at camp.
- There are 24 openings for each week of camp (2 groups of 12 children). Groups will rotate daily between the Kindergarten teachers.
- Teachers have planned different lessons for each of the 15 days of camp to ensure no repetition if your child attends camp for more than 1 week.
- The teachers have worked together to plan their lessons to ensure their daily activities are different and cohesive. A counselor will assist the teacher in each class.
- All Kindergarten classrooms are adjacent and in the Kindergarten wing of Tisdale School.
- There will be light snack periods held in the classroom.

Have a blast while getting ready for kindergarten! Make new friends before the first day of school, work on literature-based art projects, participate in musical activities and focus on honing fine motor and gross motor skills. During the first half of class, venture on a Deep Sea Journey. Our mini mariners will dive into a fun-filled program of underwater exploration. During the second part of class, prepare to jump, hop and fly... Into the Wonderful World of Bugs! Each day, explore water-themed children's books and nature-themed books with a focus on the author Eric Carle.

**RAMSEY EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM | "RED"** is a before and aftercare program offered at Dater, Hubbard and Tisdale Schools that is designed to provide caring supervision and enrichment by adult personnel to children from kindergarten to 5th grade who are enrolled and attend school in the Ramsey School District. Wrap Around Kindergarten offers your child a curriculum-based enrichment program that keeps pace with and compliments the kindergarten program offered within their school.
