



Greetings Mission College!

As part of our ongoing commitment to providing a safe environment for all campus community members, the West Valley Mission Community College District Police and the Mission College Administration have teamed up to hold a full campus evacuation drill. This event will take place on Thursday April 25<sup>th</sup> at 10:30. As more students return to campus for in person learning we recognize the need for everyone to spend a little time each semester preparing for emergencies, should one occur on campus. This exercise's focus is to test the readiness of our emergency preparedness program and to identify any gaps in capability. The event will be initiated by a WVM alert. Once you receive the alert staff identified as Building Sweepers will clear each building and escort students and all occupants to their designated evacuation assembly area. Once everyone is safely out of the buildings and accounted for, the evacuation Area Supervisor will report this information to the Mission College Command Team (MCCT) at the incident command post. Take note of the evacuation map attached below to familiarize yourself with your designated evacuation assembly area.
