







- → The Compute-STEM Project at Temple University is funded by the Office of Naval Research and focuses on developing a new and innovative approach to STEM instruction.
- → The Compute-STEM Project connects naval workforce applications, science and mathematics content, coding, computer applications and algorithmic thinking to multiple populations.
- → **Compute-STEM** lessons integrate coding and computer skills, across the disciplines of biology, chemistry, environmental science and physics.
