Who We Are:

After-School All-Stars (ASAS) is one of the leading national after-school program providers in the country. With a special focus on the middle school age group, our comprehensive school-based programs combine academics, enrichment, and health and fitness activities to help build the knowledge and skills children need to succeed, both in school and in life. ASAS is building a national model for on-site after-school programs during the hours of 3:00-6:00 p.m. providing delivery of impactful programs through our 19 chapters, all of which serve over 90,000 youth in almost 60 cities.

What We Need:

After School All Stars is seeking recent high school graduates to complete a yearlong apprenticeship/internship in Environmental Education with our brand-new EAST (Environmental All-Stars Training) Program. This position is ideal for students who are choosing to take a gap year and would like to gain relevant work experience in environmental education. The EAST program will have a strong focus on water and watersheds but will also touch on various environmental topics. The apprentice will assist in an executing hands-on watershed program, mentoring middle school students, and creating a strong sense of environmental stewardship amongst students. Must be open to go to both Philadelphia and Camden sites.

Compensation: \$18-20/hr

What You Will Do:

- Work with both ASAS and school staff to implement daily programs for middle school students
- Gauge student interests and interact with students to ensure all students are always engaged in the learning process
- Create and maintain an inviting, safe and orderly environment including ensuring cleanliness of classrooms, auditorium, and other areas where the program is held
- Prepare supplies, materials, and any other items needed before meeting the students
- Supervise students at all times and present a positive and nurturing model.
- Lead activities and program daily, Monday – Friday (per your shift)
- Support student recruitment and promotion of the program
- Follow the ASAS code of student conduct when disciplining students
- Assist with the distribution, supervision, and clean-up of snacks in the cafeteria
- Plan lessons with Environmental Education Manager to present to students

- Mentor students and assist in implementation of Youth Advisory Board
- Take trainings to further build understanding of environmental education topics, including a week-long training at the beginning of the program
- Assist in surveying program participants on knowledge, interest, and attitudes when it comes to watershed education
- Engage local community members in watershed programming and build partnerships with various local environmental organizations
- Ensure “student choice, student voice” in program design
- Should be responsible, creative, and organized.

Experience:

- Must be at least 18 years old and have a high school diploma
- Interested in environmental topics including but not limited to water, sustainability, youth mentorship, general science topics
- Ability to work cooperatively and collaboratively with school district staff, program staff, parents, and community leaders
- Ability to communicate effectively and demonstrate sensitivity to others as well as respond to critical incidents and act swiftly in an emergency situation
- Excellent organizational and creative thinking skills
- Familiarity with basic computer software programs
- Include letter of interest when applying including why you are interested in the program and why you think you are a good fit for the role.
- Optional: Include a letter of recommendation from high school teacher.
- Must be willing to receive FBI Fingerprints, PA Child Abuse Check, Criminal Background Check, and National Sex Offender Search.
