

Role	DESCRIPTION	Time
STEM Tutor	Tutor students on STEM subjects in one-on-one or group settings.	1-2 Hours During or After School
STEM Career Guide	Provide classroom presentations or, participate in Career Fairs	3-7 Hours During School
Science Fair Judge	Judge 4 th – 6 th grade or 7 th – 12 grade projects in the citywide George Washington Carver Science Fair	1 full day in February or March
