



## Penn College Advanced Manufacturing Pre-Apprenticeship – starts January 20, 2022

Pennsylvania College of Technology will offer the Advanced Manufacturing Pre-Apprentice (AMP) Program for high school juniors and seniors beginning in January 2022. The four-month AMP program is a career exploratory program that provides students with an understanding of technical training and the career paths in the manufacturing industry.

Pennsylvania's manufacturing industry is the cornerstone of the state's economic success, but skill gaps and talent shortages have left employers unable to meet demand and leave well-paying skill-based positions unfilled.

Pre-apprenticeship is a low-risk, high-impact career development activity where students can explore an interest in manufacturing and related fields.

## Benefits to the student:

- Learn foundational knowledge and skills that will prepare them for entry-level employment in a variety of manufacturing occupations
- Earn the Certified Manufacturing Associate industry certification
- Eligibility to enter a Penn College registered apprenticeship program (Mechatronics, Industrial Manufacturing Technician, CNC Operator) in partnership with a regional industry sponsor
- First step to entering a high-skill, high-wage career path in manufacturing
- Pre-apprenticeship and industry certification qualify as alternative assessments for graduation under Act 158 and the Future Ready PA Index

- AMP Schedule: January 20, 2022 May 13, 2022
- Instructional Core: 25 Online Learning Modules through Tooling U (self-directed)
- Instructional support provided by Penn College instructor
- 3 in-person, hands-on lab days
- Industry Day opportunity to meet Manufacturing Employers
- Credential exam for the Certified Manufacturing Associate

AMP is offered at no cost to school districts. PAsmart grant funds underwrite the cost of the AMP program.
