Summer Positions for Educators interested in STEM education: July 3-28, 2017.

We are a 501 (c) 3 organization seeking to hire several educators who would like to work as part of a dynamic team of teachers and interns to bring high quality STEM education to undeserved children in Philadelphia this Summer. Each teacher acts in the role of mentor and coach to 3-4 interns, who are rising juniors and seniors and college students. The interns do the actual teaching with feedback and guidance from the teachers.

We are looking for educators from K-college who love mentoring young people and want to do something exciting that will make a positive difference in the lives of children. You do not need to be an expert in STEM, though we certainly welcome math, technology and science teachers. We train everyone in the first 5 days of the program.

The position stipend is between \$3,500 and 4,000 depending on experience.

Educators must provide a resume, short bio and record of the following clearances: PA Child Abuse History, PA Criminal Records, and Federal Criminal History Record. Educators must be able to transport by car 3-4 interns and materials for programs from base camp to our community partners in Philadelphia.
