

Associate Benevolent Society Covid-19 policy

In accordance with Iowa Department of Public Health guidelines as well Gov. Kim Reynolds declaration on 4/27/20, that some Iowa counties (Clinton County being in that number) would be able to have businesses, non-profits, etc., reopen under certain circumstances, the Associate Benevolent Society is planning to reopen our store on Monday, May 18, 2020 understanding our organization will go forward with this opening ONLY IF the following store rules are used and strictly enforced:

1. Only 1 person per household will be allowed into ABS store at 1 time.
2. All clients must wear masks, which they will supply for themselves, the entire time they are in ABS' store.
3. All clients must apply hand sanitizer immediately upon entering store.
4. All clients will have no more than 15 minutes to obtain needed items, after which time they will immediately leave the ABS building.
5. The maximum number of people allowed into the entire ABS building at any 1 time will be 5 people, including staff.
6. Social distancing, meaning 6 feet between all people, will be strictly enforced.
7. All persons wishing to enter the store will be asked "Have you been well for the last 48 hours?" & will only be allowed into the store if they answer "Yes."
8. Staff will sign clients in/out.

These will be ABS' store rules until further notice.
