Autism Spectrum Disorders are currently being diagnosed in approximately 1 of every 54 children according to a 2020 study by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. 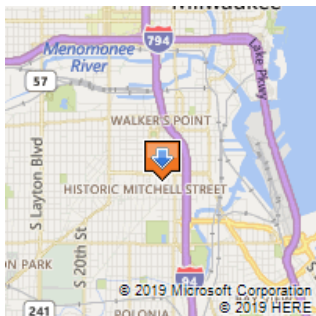

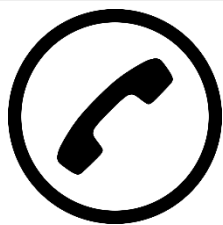

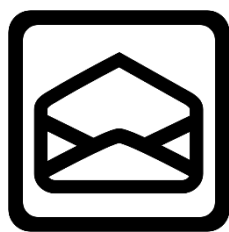
