### **May 17: Plant Shopping**

### **May 19 and June 2: 9:30 - Noon: Meandering Path Flagging & Clean-Up Party!**

We'll begin marking out our Path — come and help decide where it will go! — and then we'll begin the needed clean-up (trash we find in the woods, getting rid of dead branches that might knock us in the head when we walk, etc.). There will be coffee and refreshments both times!

### **May 23, 1:00-3:00 pm: Planting Party! *Welcoming Entryway***

### **June 3, following the Service: Lilac Pruning Demonstration**

Have you got an old lilac that is 20' tall and only blooms at the very top? Or, do you have a young lilac that stubbornly refuses to bloom at all? Both of those can be fixed with proper pruning!

We'll demonstrate on the lilacs at the edge of our parking lot, which are among those that haven't bloomed. Come and learn how to prune your lilac and rejuvenate it.
